About this qualification – The QCTO hairdressing qualification is registered in on the SAQA framework and recognized Nationally as well as Internationally.

- Provided at THASA: Practical and knowledge modules provided full-time during the first year, and part time during first half of the second year.
- Workplace Modules will be completed in a hair salon, while earning a small salary, form the start of the second year, to gain required practical experience (3240 hours) - about 1 ½ to 2 years, before entering the National Trade Test.

What are the payment options? Pay the course off over 18 months, or apply for a student loan at a financial institution,
